## Will you rise to the "Challenge?"

A "Challenge" is "a summons to take part in a contest or trial of strength . . . a demanding or difficult task." Something "challenging" is something, "demanding, formidable, difficult, exacting, hard; stimulating" (Reader's Digest Oxford Complete Wordfinder).

## Syllabus for "The Colossian Challenge:"

"The Colossian Challenge" is an intensive personal study in the Book of Colossians in the Bible. Welcome to this exciting adventure! Please follow the instructions below.

#### Step I:

- 1. Read through the Book of Colossians at least 10 times. Keep a journal of your readings. Get a hard cover notebook where you <u>record the dates</u> and <u>sections</u> of your readings and the lessons you have learned that particular day.
- 2. Carefully *hand-copy* the Book of Colossians---*Write it with your own hand*. You may get an exercise book (48 pages) for this. This will form your own unique handwritten copy of Colossians. This principle is drawn from *Deuteronomy 17:18-20*.
- 3. As you read, memorize at least four (4) key verses that strike you. (see Psalm 119:11)
- 4. Write down at least ten (10) important lessons you learn out of your reading of Colossians. How will you apply them in your life?
- 5. Teach other people about the message of Colossians. Do either Alternative A or B to do this:

#### **Alternative A:**

Prepare and preach three 20-30 minute sermons to a group <u>of five or more</u> people. Information is available to *help you learn how to prepare and preach a sermon*.

#### **Alternative B:**

Prepare and lead a series of three to five Bible study lessons for 3 – 10 people, based on Colossians. Information is available to *help you learn how to lead a Bible Study Group*.

6. Attend a Graduation celebration on the Colossian Challenge. In order to qualify for this graduation, you will need to do a "Check-Out" to confirm that you have met the requirements. At the graduation, you will receive a Certificate to congratulate you on your successful completion of the Colossian Challenge.

You will also be informed of the next step in your Bible Reading development.
